- 7.05pm Over 1000 churches will ring their bells across the nation and beyond as a celebration of peace. St John's in Ruyton will ring until 7.15pm.
- 7.05pm A Cry for Peace Around the World.
- 7.10pm Wendy Lowdon will recite a WWI poem
- 7.20pm Rev Lucinda Burns: "A Tribute to the Millions"
This will be followed by reading the names of the fallen and then a medley of songs.
- 7.40pm End of event. Optional visit to the war memorial to pay personal respects.
