Served in the special reserve
since he was 18, transferring to
the Line Regiment in June 1914

He died of wounds on 4th March
1916, aged 30, the battalion
being under heavy shelling while
billeted in Ypres town

Buried in the Military Cemetery
in Lijssenthoek , Belgium
