Born 1891 in Ruyton XI Towns

Son of Abel and Margaret of Hill
Cottage, The Cliffe, Ruyton XI Towns

Brother of Thomas (died an infant),
Margaret Mary, Annie and Elizabeth
Hannah

Brother of George, John Abel,
Charles Henry (who also died),
Cecil and Frederick (who all served)

His father was as labourer and he
worked in a flour mill in Liverpool



He died of neuritis and exposure
in hospital in France on
7th February, 1917, aged 26

Buried in the Varennes Military
Cemetery, France
